<p>Scripture:</p> <p>But those that trust the Lord will find new strength. They will be strong like eagles soaring upward on wings, they will walk and run without getting tired.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Isaiah 40:31 (CEV)</p>	<p>Comment:</p> <p>I have only seen eagles soaring on T.V. wild life programmes – what a majestic sight!!!!</p> <p>Their two wings gently undulating (not really flapping) together in unity searching for the ‘thermals’ rising effortlessly.</p> <p>Is that a picture of a couple praying together in unity, waiting for God’s Holy Spirit to refresh and lift them so that they can soar above the earthly issues they are likely to face that day and get God’s perspective on them.</p> <p>An eagle needs both wings to be able to soar – a couple needs each other to rise above and see from God’s perspective the daily tasks they are about to face.</p>
